The Daily Creative Food Co.'s hook is naming most of their items after newspapers. I had no choice but to try the Miami Herald Pollo — lightly breaded chicken cutlet with chopped artichokes, olives, roasted peppers, provolone and tangy vinaigrette on amazingly fresh ciabatta. A fine sandwich, but, sorry, I preferred the Sun Post — Black Forest ham, brie, caramelized onions, basil and honey mustard on a baguette. Another item worthy of page one: the Journalist panini, a comforting warm blend of three cheeses (mozzarella, provolone, goat) with basil and truffle oil. Don't be tempted by the \$15.95 lobster club — no substance, all fluff.
